So Julián sets out on a campaign to be allowed to wear a cat mask in his ID photograph. Once he reaches his goal, his hybrid, half-cat half-human identity begins to steer towards animalization, and this will compromise his relationship with his partner.

He is also involved in the micro-theatre project Microefectos Dramatúrxicos in which he wrote and produced nineteen short plays. He is also one of the coordinators of the up-and-coming audiovisual project Cinerxias in Lugo.

SANDRA SÁNCHEZ (Narón, 1971) has an extensive career as editor and director. In 2011 she premiered her first feature film, *Tralas Luces* (*Behind the lights*), a very personal project on which she worked for four years, and where she assumed the direction, scriptwritting, editing and DOP. It was premiered in the San Sebastian Film Festival (Zabaltegi New Directors) She has edited films such as *Esquece Monelos* (*Monelos*. *Forget no river*), by Ángeles Huerta, *Migas de pan* (*Breadcrumbs*), by Manane Rodríguez, or *Rafael*, by Xavier Bermúdez, among others. She currently works for the Audiovisual Production Lab of the Science Museum in A Coruña, and she's also writing the script of her next feature film, *La Nadadora*, a project closely related to *A nena azul* (*The Blue Child*).

THE SPECTRORIUM

The Spectrorium is a journey in two phases through the realm of the senses. The questioning of what is real begins beyond the limits of the visible spectrum. The animal eye-view scales to the insect advancing through a floral system of bleeding colors. Between the ultraviolet and the infrared the rules of the habitat are forged like motors of survival. The attraction for light is in the nature of being alive, but in this world of savage shapes, light and darkness can create an intermediate space, where all specters and primal fantasies reign.



JUDITH ADATABERNA (Vilaboa, 1992). While studying Fine Art she discovered her passion for the image, focusing on several aspects including photography, fashion and experimental cinema. Working for brands or designers as a photographer, she directed the costume design of the latest Lois Patiño film *Tempo Vertical* (*Vertical Time*). In 2017 she obtained a student grant from Master Lav, an experimental film laboratory. Her work has been exhibited at festivals such as the Curtocircuíto Film Festival, the Bendita Tú Festival of Buenos Aires, or Filmadrid where she was invited for one of the Vanguardias Live events. She is currently filming her next work in Iceland selected by SIM art residency in Reykjavik.

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
